## MESSAGE FROM CHAIRMAN

It is my pleasure to present to you the Foundation's annual report for 2022. This year marks the continuation of our celebration of the College's 170th Anniversary. Under the theme "Celebrate Our Heritage, Build Our Future," we have been engaging all our constituents to commemorate this remarkable occasion.

I am pleased to report that our celebration activities have been successful, including the 170th Anniversary Seminar Series from March to April 2022, the Open Day of St. Paul's College on 26th November 2022 and Exhibition Day of St. Paul's College Primary School on 16th Dec 2022. These events united students, staff, alumni, and friends of the College, reflecting our community's deep commitment to the school's mission and values.

I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to our Public Relations and Communications Committee, who worked closely with the College to plan and execute a PR campaign that integrated the projection of our brand identity while planning the celebration activities for our 170th Anniversary. This year, the PR Committee helped with the Brand video, which would help to raise the profile of the College and to carry out its mission.

Thanks to all our supporters for their commitment to St. Paul's College and the Foundation's mission. We remain steadfast in our commitment to providing the best possible education for our students, and we look forward to working with you in the years ahead to build a brighter future for St. Paul's College.

### Enhancement Project Highlights

We are pleased to report that the School Enhancement Project has made significant progress in 2022. The foundation for the new structure of Phase 2 was completed in July of last year. The main construction of the New Entrance and the Indoor Swimming Pool commenced in September 2022 and is making good progress towards the target completion date. If everything goes according to schedule, we will see its completion during the new semester of 2023/24, which will result in an additional 1,300 square meters of floor area at the New Multi-purpose Main Entrance Hall and an indoor swimming pool.

In 2022, we have spent 19.2 million on the construction, and an additional 10 million is needed to complete the main construction. Our next fundraising target is to build a modern and functional library on the 9th and 10th floors, with an additional 161 square meters area to cater to contemporary needs.

## Endowment Challenge

The Alumni Endowment Fund for Scholarships has continued to make progress in 2022. The Fund was initiated by alumni who treasured the time they spent at St. Paul's College, where they learned the spirit of inclusiveness through a student body of diverse backgrounds. The Endowment Fund will be used to support qualified students with lesser means so that they would not be denied admission due to financial constraints. In 2022, the program supported five students, helping them to pursue their academic aspirations and achieve their full potential.

To kickstart the Endowment Fund, an alumnus pledged a matching fund of \$30 million in 2020 to challenge more alumni to join the effort. Our fundraising team has worked tirelessly to promote the scholarship to the SPC community, delivering key messages through newsletters, press releases, and alumni sharing sessions. With the deadline of June 30th 2023 in sight, we will continue to pitch the underlying significance of this scholarship and rally further support from the alumni. We believe that our efforts will not be overlooked.


## Annual Giving Drive

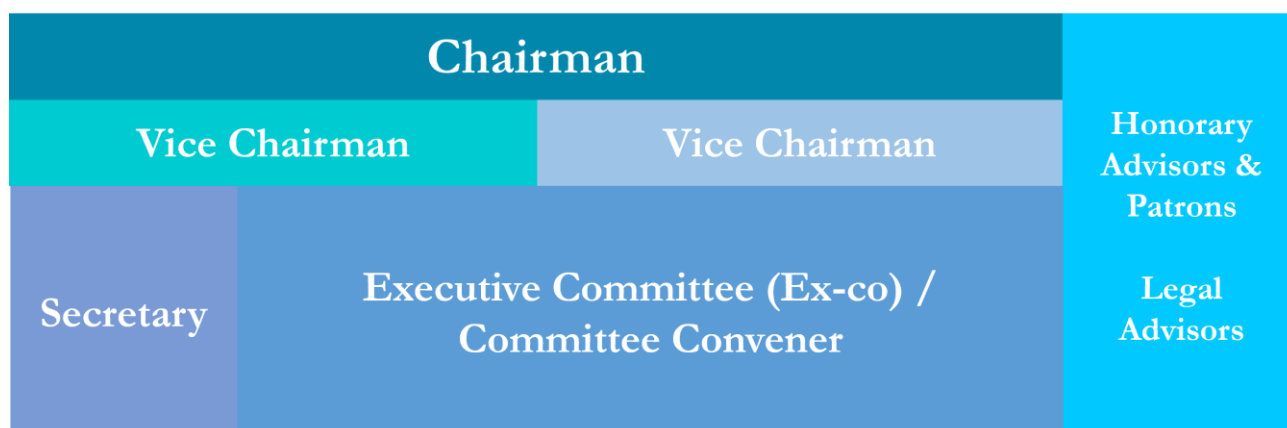

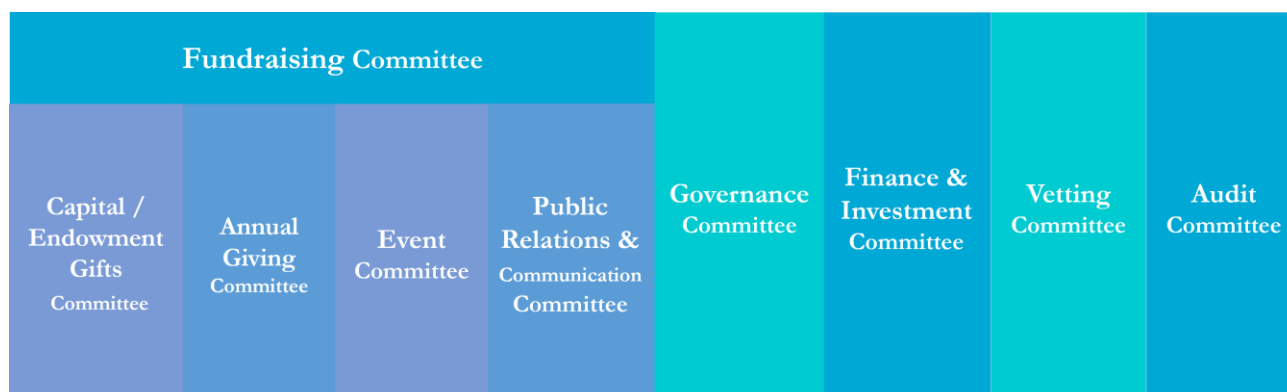

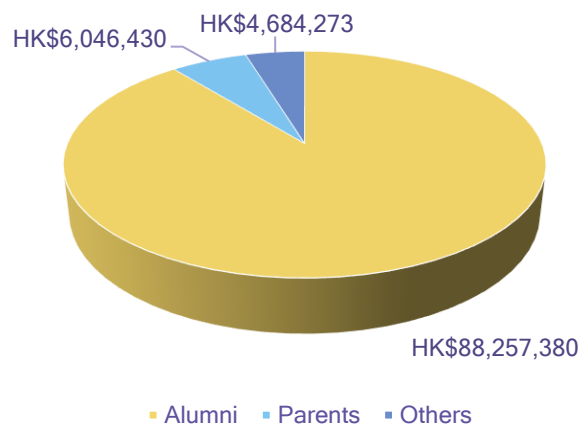


# TOTAL FUND RAISED

(Since Inception to Apr 2023)

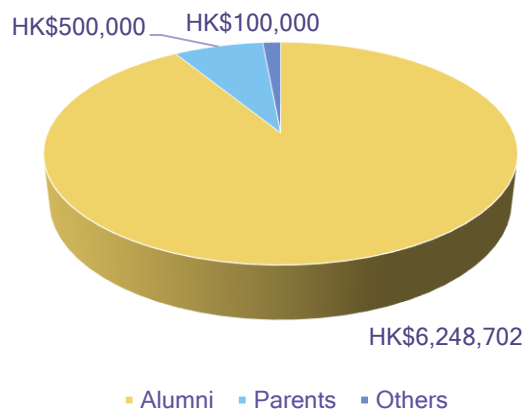
## Capital Fund (HK\$ 98,988,083.92)

In 2019, St. Paul's College began its second enhancement of the campus to meet the needs of the 21st Century education. The objective of Capital Fund is to finance the School Enhancement Project, to augment the learning environment and facilities of the school premise for our students.



## Endowment Fund (HK\$ 6,848,701.5)

In parallel with campus enhancement, St. Paul's College has pledged to assist qualified students who are financially constrained. The College has a proud tradition of welcoming students from a wide spectrum of family backgrounds which creates an environment for students to experience diversity. The Endowment Fund is set up to let St. Paul's College to open its doors to students regardless of their backgrounds.





# FUNDS AND PROJECT REPORT

## Capital Fund

Thanks to the special financial arrangement from the College Council to enable the construction of the New Entrance and Indoor Swimming Pool began in September 2022. An additional HK\$10 million was needed from the Primary School Fund to complete this phase of the project. However, the fundraising team has set a goal of raising another HK\$10 million before the project's completion by the end of 2023.

The pandemic and economic downturn made fundraising more challenging, and the fundraising team was not able to organize campaigns as planned in 2022. However, Alumni Sharing sessions gradually resumed in the second half of the year.



Despite these difficult circumstances, the Fundraising Committee raised HK\$6.2 million, which is a significant achievement. The Foundation is grateful for the committee's efforts and the support of the donors who made this possible.





## Endowment Fund

In January 2022, the PR Committee arranged an interview with the Principal, Mr. Yuen Dick Yan, Dennis and an alumnus Mr. Lo Hoi Kwong, Sunny, by HKET to discuss the Alumni Endowment Fund for Scholarships. The Endowment Fund is established as a long-term investment initiative that aims to generate sustainable income to support the scholarship program.

# 延續聖保羅書院DNA 校友創獎學基金

## 大家樂羅開光：學校應像小社會 吸各階層

開光坦言，學校應像一個小社會，讓學生從小學習互相包容及與不同人溝通，他形容當年正是在這種多元環境中成長，「成長後人生N次得益」，故冀成立獎學基金，繼續吸納各階層學生入讀聖保羅書院，延續母校DNA。

會所同人溝通技巧，同去旺角結魚蛋係唔同嚟……你自個去同唔同人溝通，自個培養咁會好好多。」

羅開光尤記得，在學時同學可一起去豪宅看星星，又可到舊樓天棚一學習；亦能看見生於務農家庭的同學，總衝忙趕回家做家務，成績卻永遠名列前茅；以及「有錢仔」因管教嚴格，不得外出的境況，形容大家在這環境下總能有同理心地互相理解，也讓他更早了解到各階層需要，更冀幫助家庭條件較差的學生。是次特意提出成立基金以獎學金形式支援母校學生學習開支，望有能力的學生不用因經濟問題卻步。

羅開光提到，有同學曾坦言，當初考入聖保羅書院，父親擔心他會因家境被看輕，不斷叮囑要小心；該同學更自喻入讀時像「劉地地進大觀園」，惟實際卻從未受欺負，反而老師知其英文能力較弱，不斷設法鼓勵他學習。

**受舊生感染 盼活到老學到老**

羅開光相信，這同是社會對聖保羅的感觀，冀獎學金的設立可讓大眾知道聖保羅書院是一間包容度高，且舊生均來自不同階層的學校，望家長放心之餘更望消除偏見。

談及近年積極參與母校各項活動，羅開光稱，是受到數個有心舊生感染，看見他們對學校事務

During the interview, they discussed various ideas to promote the Endowment Fund, such as targeted outreach to potential donors, regular progress updates, and the creation of a dedicated webpage on the Foundation's website. An essential aspect is the recruitment of suitable candidates for the program. Additionally, the Foundation has worked to educate the SPC community about the advantages of endowment giving and its positive impact on the Foundation's work.

One of the highlights of the discussion were emphasized on alumni engagement. Seeing the Foundation's commitment to long-term sustainability has encouraged alumni to consider making a lasting impact through endowment giving. This has resulted in increased support for the Fund and a growing sense of belonging among alumni who share a future commitment to the College's mission.

## General Fund

The Foundation raises funds to support various projects, including the relocation of the Primary School, the global classroom, service projects, student scholarships, and e-learning. Alumni and donors have generously contributed to the General Fund by making donations and purchasing much-needed resources for the school. which has helped enhance the learning environment for the students.



## Souvenirs for 170<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

As part of our anniversary festivities, we produced a range of commemorative souvenirs that were available for purchase through our E-shop. As the 170th anniversary celebrations come to a close, any remaining stocks will be sold at special occasions, such as the Open Day and 170<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Dinner.

During the College Open Days and Primary School Exhibition Day in 2022, the Foundation generated over HK\$90,000 and HK\$40,000, respectively, by selling the souvenirs. We are grateful for the support of our alumni, parents, and friends who helped make this possible.

## Public Relations & Communication

St. Paul's College and Asia Society Hong Kong Center collaborated to organize the 170th Anniversary Seminar Series, featuring renowned alumni and distinguished scholars. The theme of the series was "Build Our Future," aiming to bring hope and opportunities to the generations ahead and prepare them for the future. The webinars provided valuable insights into major trends, challenges, and opportunities in areas such as technological innovation, healthcare, work and education, and climate change. The Plenary Session featured ten eminent speakers who shared their views on building a better learning environment and a brighter future for youth. The Foundation supported the event, by sponsoring media partnerships and inviting students, parents, and teachers from other schools to join the seminars. Three Open TV interviews were arranged to promote the event. It aimed to raise awareness of the Seminar Series and attract a larger audience, including potential donors and supporters from SPC Community.



St. Paul's College has benefited greatly from the 170th Anniversary Seminar Series, particularly in terms of ongoing sustainability projects. The Public Relations and Communication Committee members have worked closely with the Principal and faculty members on various initiatives. Four teachers completed UNSDGs training, which was integrated into the curriculum. The Solar Harvest project installed 70 panels and joined the Feed-in Tariff Scheme. These efforts led to St. Paul's College being recognized as an excellent demonstration school in "Green Campus 2.0" and "Learning to Conserve Energy Program" by the Environmental Protection Department.

In addition to the Committee's significant contributions to the Seminar Series and ongoing projects at the College, they also played a crucial role for the production of the College's brand video, which was sponsored by the Foundation. Their efforts in promoting the College and supporting its mission have been invaluable, and we are grateful for their dedication and hard work.
